In response to an FTC petition filed by the Physicians Committee for Responsible Medicine (PCRM), two national dairy advertising campaigns that were actually overseen by the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture have stopped claiming that dairy products cause weight loss, because such claims are not true. PCRM charged that the dairy industry used false and misleading advertising in its multimillion-dollar, celebrity-filled marketing campaign. According to a study in the American Journal of Clinical Nutrition, dairy product consumption either has little or no effect on weight loss, or actually increases body weight.
